



## Request for Organizational Affiliate Status with the Center for English as a Second Language at the University of Arizona

An affiliate organization is a government or educational agency, school, embassy, or corporation which supervises students at CESL and provides billable financial support for their students. In order to encourage future placements, CESL offers group [tuition discounts to affiliate organizations](#) that recruit, apply for, and place students at CESL. Students who self pay but are "reimbursed" by affiliate sponsors are not eligible for affiliate tuition discounts.

Affiliates must make full payment or include a financial guarantee statement with their students' applications. The financial guarantee letter must be current and

- specify English language training or ESL
- be addressed to the Center for English as a Second Language, University of Arizona
- include a billing address.

Affiliates who are billed for services must pay in full within 60 days or risk losing their affiliate tuition discount.
