CESL offers intensive English language study for students planning to pursue academic, professional, and technical careers requiring proficiency in the English language. Typical enrollment averages about 100 students from 15-25 countries. Our two-month sessions begin in August, October, January, March, and June. We have 4-week programs in May, June and July. Upon request, students can adjust exit dates to meet personal needs. To enhance language learning CESL offers many activities beyond the classroom; in addition, escorted social and cultural activities as well as educational trips throughout Arizona, including the Grand Canyon, are available.
