



Teen English Program
4-Week Summer Job on Campus
7/10-8/4, 2006

Background Information:

The Center for English as a Second Language is running an intensive English program for international teenagers from July 10 to August 4, 2006.

Some of these teens will be staying in a U of A dormitory. They are from Taiwan, Mexico, Russia, and other countries.

These teens will be in English class from 10am to 3pm Monday through Thursday, and they will have activities planned for them on Friday.

Job Description:

We are looking for a U of A student to live in the dormitory during this 4-week program.

Responsibilities include:

- 1) be available when students are in the dorm
- 2) make sure students get to class in the morning
- 3) help students get involved in campus activities after class
- 4) make sure students obey all dorm rules
- 5) plan evening and weekend activities with the students
- 6) participate in students' Friday trips
- 7) drive a university van for Friday activities

Qualifications:

- 1) full time student at the U.of A. Fall 2006
- 2) HOV trained
- 3) prior experience in working with teenagers

Compensation:

Free room for the 4-week duration of the program plus a \$1000 salary
