



Verification of Visa Denial

To the CESL applicant: If your visa is denied, you may receive a refund of your pre-paid tuition. This form must be completed and returned to us by an official of the U.S. embassy or consulate in your country. Please present this form to the official to return to us.

To the U.S. Embassy or Consular Official: In response to recent trends in issuing student visas, we have instituted a procedure for the pre-payment of tuition. To ensure that an applicant is sincere in his wish to attend our intensive English program, we ask for payment of the tuition before issuing the form I-20. The amount of pre-paid tuition will be noted on the I-20. If the prospective student is denied a visa, we will refund the amount paid, but only if we have verification of the denial from an embassy or consular official. We ask that you complete the form below and return it to us by fax. Thank you for your help.
